Dear Sirs,

We would like to bring the following to your notice:-

We have had a visit from a Melbourne resident, Mr. F. Loeffler, of 728 Burwood Rd., Hawthorn, who wants us to investigate a matter that was published in the Hungarian paper "Uj Kelet" in Tel-Aviv on 14th October, 1960.

This referred to a Hungarian theatrical personality, who, when searching for his mother's grave in Austria traced there at a place called Neudoerfl, three graves carrying the names of Magda Loeffler, Sara Davidovits and Magda Weisz.

Now, Mr. Loeffler had a sister by the name of Magda, born in Balasagyarmat in 1924, of whom he knew that she had been seen somewhere in Austria alive after having been liberated by the Russians from Auschwitz in 1945.

He is naturally most anxious to ascertain whether the Magda Loeffler buried on the Catholic cemetery in Neudoerfl is his sister, but even if this is not the case, he has requested us to see to it that the three bodies are transferred to a Jewish cemetery, if at all possible.

Your kind assistance in this matter would be greatly appreciated, and we are looking forward to your reply in due course.
